
- **1.** Unclip and remove the panel above the radio. (Figures A and B)
- 2. Unclip and remove the entire trim panel surrounding the radio and A/C controls. (Figure C)
- **3.** Remove (4) Phillips screws securing the radio. (Figure D)








Dash Disassembly

Nissan Versa S, Versa S+, Versa / SV (base) 2014, Versa 2012-2013

- Unclip and remove the entire panel surrounding the radio including the A/C vents. (Figure A)
- **2.** Remove (4) Phillips screws securing the radio. (Figure B) Continue to kit assembly




Nissan Juke 2011-2014

- **1.** Unclip and remove the climate control panel. (Figure A)
- 2. Remove (2) Phillips screws securing the radio trim panel. (Figure B)
- 3. Remove (4) Philips screws securing the radio. (Figure C)






Dash Disassembly

Nissan Rogue 2011, Rogue S 2012-2013, Rogue SV (with SL package) 2012-2013, Rogue Select (with lower model radio) 2014-2015


- If equipped with center speaker: Unclip and remove the grille then remove (4) Phillips screws to remove the speaker. (Figure A)
- 2. Unclip and remove the panel below the radio including the A/C controls. (Figure B)
- Unclip the radio trim including the A/C vents then unplug the hazard switch and remove the panel. (Figure C)
- **4.** Remove (4) Phillips screws securing the radio. (Figure D)








Chevrolet City Express (without NAV) 2015-up

Nissan Cube 2009-2014 Nissan NV200 (without NAV) 2013-up


- 1. Unclip and remove the recirculate/ fresh slide button. (Figure A)
- 2. Unclip and remove the entire panel surrounding the radio including the a/c vents. (Figure B)
- 3. Remove (4) Phillips screws securing the radio. (Figure C)


Nissan NV 2012-2014, Nissan NV (without NAV) 2015-up

- Unclip and remove the A/C vent to the right side of the factory radio. (Figures A)
- 2. Remove the (2) Phillips screws exposed behind vent on radio trim panel. (Figure B)
- Unclip and remove the left A/C vent next to the instrument display. (Figure C)
- **4.** Unclip the top edge of the knee bolster panel below the steering column and let hang. (Figure D)




Dash Disassembly (Cont)

Nissan NV 2012-2014, Nissan NV (without NAV) 2015-up


- **5.** Unclip the circle trim around the key cylinder.
- **6.** Unclip and remove the gauge cluster trim panel. (Figures E)
- Remove (2) Phillips screws exposed behind the panel on the left side of the radio trim panel. (Figure F)
- 8. Unclip and remove the trim panel surrounding the factory radio. (Figure G)
- **9.** Remove (4) Phillips screws securing the radio. (Figure H) Continue to kit assembly





Dash Disassembly


Nissan Quest (without NAV or rear seat entertainment) 2011-2012

- Unclip and remove the panels from the bottom left and right side of the center console. (Figure A)
- **2.** Remove (2) clips per side exposed behind lower panels. (Figure B)
- **3.** Unclip and pull center console toward rear of vehicle. (Figure C)


Note: You do not have to fully remove console.

4. Unclip and remove the trim panel to the left of the shifter housing the start/stop button. (Figure D)







Dash Disassembly (Cont)

Nissan Quest (without NAV or rear seat entertainment) **2011-2012**

- Unclip and remove the panel on the end of the passenger side of the dash. (Figures E)
- Remove (1) Phillips screw from the trim panel above the glove box then unclip and remove the panel. (Figure F)
- Remove (1) Phillips screw from the cup holder panel then unclip and remove the panel. (Figure G)
- 8. Remove (2) Phillips screws from the A/C control panel and unclip and let hang. (Figure H)
- Remove (2) Phillips screws from the bottom of the radio trim panel including the vents then unclip and remove the panel. (Figure H)
- **10.** Remove (4) Phillips screws securing the radio. (Figure I)












Kit Assembly

ISO DDIN radio provision

- **1.** Remove the brackets from the factory radio.
- 2. Secure the brackets to the aftermarket radio using the screws supplied with the aftermarket radio. (Figure A)
- Locate the factory wiring harness and antenna connector in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapters from Metra and/or AXXESS.
- **4.** Place the *ISO DDIN trim plate* on the front of the radio. (Figure B)
- **5.** Reassemble the dash in reverse order of disassembly.
