


- Unclip and remove entire panel surrounding radio and a/c control all the way over to left side of steering wheel. (Figure A)

- Remove (2) Phillips screws (1 per side) securing factory pocket to radio/pocket bracket assembly. (Figure C, D)





- Remove the metal "DIN" sleeve and plastic trim ring from the aftermarket radio.
- 2. Mount the ISO Brackets to the radio with the screws supplied with the radio. (Figure A)
