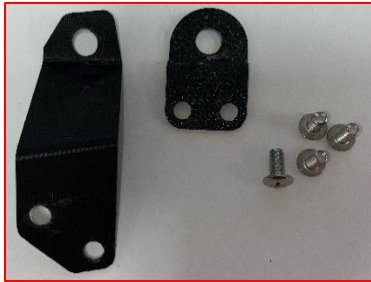

Prior to install, install the upper and lower speaker pod brackets into the outer edge of speaker pod. In this example we're using the Left (drivers) speaker pod, process is same with right pod.



Remove hood and windshield if equipped. *Please refer to owner's manual for proper removal instructions.*

1. From the exterior locate the 6 push clips, lift center pin and remove base.



2. Remove the two push clips of the center mount cup holders. To remove cupholder, pull back in direction of the seats.
3. Remove the push clip above the left and right cup holders.
4. Open glove box, remove the 4 T25 screws holding in locking storage. Lift off box, and remove clip in dash pad.
5. Then remove the two clips behind information cluster, then reinstall factory panels in reverse order of removal.



6. Place dash pad out of the way, and route all necessary audio wiring.
7. Remove the T40 and T25 bolts from lower dashboard, on storage cubby.
8. The storage pocket has two holes, the larger is for the audio wires, the smaller is to mount the pod in the pocket. Use the Phillips screw to hold speaker pod in place.
9. Complete installation by reinstalling the T40 and T25 bolts, repeat on other side.
